This conference took place on Friday, 24 November 2006 in Regent's College in London. It was hosted by the Refugee Enterprise project to inform participants about the Refugees into business project and to discuss refugee enterprise.

The keynote speaker was **Margaret Hodge MP**, Minister of State for Industry & the Regions and our panel of experts included representatives from central and local government. The conference was attended by representatives from the public, private and community and voluntary sectors.
